



High School Supply List 2017-2018

The lists below are designed to help families equip high school students adequately for the coming school year. The general list is meant to be used as a guideline for all students, while the specific course lists let students know which supplies are **required** for individual classes.

General Supplies

- pencils – 2 or 3 packages of wooden pencils with a pencil sharpener or mechanical pencils with an ample supply of lead
- pens – 10 blue, 10 black, 3 red
- subject dividers
- two 2" or 2.5" ring binders
- loose leaf (1000-1500 sheets)
- pencil crayons
- ruler
- thesaurus
- dictionary – A good dictionary is a very important tool. The [Oxford Canadian Dictionary](#) in soft cover is a great dictionary for a reasonable price and will be useful for grades 9-12. Dictionaries are important tools for all courses but are **required** for all ELA courses.

Course Specific Supplies

Doctrine

- geometry set with dividers, compass, protractor, triangle rulers
- hard, clear, plastic 30-centimeter ruler (with both metric and imperial)
- scientific calculator (Each student must have their own calculator. Calculator apps on devices will not be allowed for tests and quizzes.)
- Texas Instruments TI-84 graphing calculator (for grade 12 Applied Math)
